2022 - The ETL, Data Warehouse and Data Catalog Project was initiated.

- Conducted a comprehensive assessment of existing data systems and processes.
- Identified key data sources and integration points.
- Developed a detailed project plan and timeline.
- Initiated the procurement process for data warehouse and catalog solutions.

2023 and current – Issued an RFP seeking a technology platform to better manage our data assets across disparate and siloed data systems, and to accommodate the University's common and distinct business needs.

- Issued an RFP to select a data warehouse and catalog solution.
- Received responses from several vendors.
- Conducted a thorough evaluation of proposals.
- Identified key requirements and evaluation criteria.
- Engaged in discussions with shortlisted vendors.
- Completed the RFP process and selected a vendor.

Second Quarter 2024 – Conclusion of the RFP with potential selection of a new Data Warehouse and Data Catalog solution.

- Finalized the selection of a new data warehouse and catalog solution.
- Initiated the implementation process.
- Conducted data migration and integration testing.
- Provided training to end users.
- Monitored system performance and user adoption.
