Retaliation	Retaliation. Adverse action taken against a person participating in a sex and genderbased discrimination report or investigation because of that participation.
Sexor Genderbased Discrimination	"Sex and gendebased discrimination" occurs when an individual is treated le favorably on the basis of that person's sex or gender, which may also include or the basis of sexual orientian, gender identity or expression, pregnancy or pregnancyrelated condition, or a sex stereotype.
Sexual Assault	"Sexual assault" includes rape, sodomy, sexual assault with an object, fondling incest, and statutory rape. The definitions of those acts follow: a. "Rape" is non consensual vaginal or anal penetration of a person with a penis no matter how slight, including instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of their age or because of their incapacitation. b. "Sodomy" is counsensual oral or anal penetration of another person, including instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of their age or because of their incapacitation. Examples of sodomy are roomsensual anal penetration with a tongue or finge or oral copulation (mouth to genital contact or genital to mouth contact), no matter how slight the penetration or contact. c. "Sexual assault with an object" is norconsensual vaginal or anal penetration with an object no matter how slight the penetration. d. "Fondling" is the touching of the breasts, buttocks, or genitals of another person for the purpose of sexual gratification without the consent of the victim, including instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of their agbetorause of incapacitation. Fondling can occur over or under clothing.
Sexual Exploitation	"Sexual exploitationoccurs when a person takes non
