If you're interested in the efresh schedle of a specic table, enter the full table name in the Table Namefield. To seath for table names that stare certain citeria, use the wildcard% for your search.

For example, you could type PHRHIST the Table Name field to find the normal refresh schedule of that specific table. Or you ould enter P% if you want to see the of resh status of all of the tables hat begin with P (payroll related tables).

You can also se the Application field if you want to see the refresh schedule for sets of tables in an application area (Finance, HR, Studiet). To see all of the payoll-related tables, you carenter Payroll% in the field. To view a list of all of the position-related tables, you can enter HR% or HR—Posn Ctl% the field.

- 12. Your results will be displayed in a separate window or tab in your browser. Only a certain number of results can be displayed on the results page. If you se a Fetch More Recordsbutton at the end of the page, the more query results are available. Selecting the button will redisplay the page with the next batch of results.
